

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This warranty covers National Air Parts Pty Ltd (NAP) insulated and uninsulated flexible ducting.

The flexible ducting must be installed in accordance with NAP procedures and incorporates associated HVAC components and products supplied by NAP.

The warranty covers only the affected portion of the installation and is limited to replacement of parts only. Removal and re-installation costs are not included.

The warranty will only apply if appropriate flexible duct support mechanisms are in place, in either ceiling or underfloor applications, and the flexible ducting is taped correctly to all connections.

This warranty does not cover damage caused by birds, animals, insects or acts of God, misuse, abuse, or negligence.

NAP flexible ducting needs to be stored or installed in a dry environment. Warranty will be void if damage occurs in exposed weather conditions, direct sunlight or damp environments.

Warranty claims will only be recognised if:

- The warranty certificate is completed at the time of installation and certificate details are forwarded to NAP within one month of installation.
- Claims are inspected by NAP representatives in situ, and no changes to the original installation have occurred.

 The warranty applies only to the original purchase.

 Warranty will be rendered void if installed by an unlicensed installer.
